A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Criminal Law – Attempted Second–Degree Murder – Penalty**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the maximum term of imprisonment that may be imposed for
4 the offense of attempted second–degree murder; and generally relating to attempted
5 second–degree murder.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Criminal Law**

14 2–206.

15 A person who attempts to commit murder in the second degree is guilty of a felony
16 and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding [30] 40 years.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 2023.
