- FOR the purpose of renaming the Chesapeake and Atlantic Coastal Bays 2010 Trust Fund 4 5 to be the Chesapeake Bay and State Waters Trust Fund; modifying the purpose of 6 the Fund to include the restoration and protection of the health of the waters of the 7 State; expanding the use of the Fund to include certain projects to improve and 8 protect the health of the waters of the State; requiring the publisher of the Annotated 9 Code of Maryland, in consultation with and subject to the approval of the Department of Legislative Services, to correct any cross-references or terminology 10 11 rendered incorrect by this Act; making conforming changes; and generally relating 12 to the Chesapeake and Atlantic Coastal Bays 2010 Trust Fund.

- 1 There is a Chesapeake [and Atlantic Coastal Bays 2010] BAY AND STATE 2 WATERS Trust Fund.
- 3 The purpose of the Fund is to provide financial assistance necessary to advance Maryland's progress in meeting the goals established in the 2014 Chesapeake Bay 4 Watershed Agreement for the restoration of the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries, 5 6 including the Patuxent River, and to restore AND PROTECT the health of the [Atlantic Coastal Bays and their tributaries WATERS OF THE STATE, by focusing limited financial 8 resources on nonpoint source pollution control projects in all regions of the State.
- 9 (1) (f) The Fund may be used only for the implementation of nonpoint source 10 pollution control projects to:
- 11 Support State and local watershed implementation plans by (i) targeting limited financial resources on the most effective nonpoint source pollution control 12 13 projects; and
- Improve AND PROTECT the health of the [Atlantic Coastal Bays 14 (ii) and their tributaries WATERS OF THE STATE. 15
- 16 It is the intent of the General Assembly that, when possible, moneys in 17 the Fund shall be granted to local governments and other political subdivisions for 18 agricultural, forestry, stream and wetland restoration, and urban and suburban 19 stormwater nonpoint source pollution control projects, including up to 25% in matching 20 funds to local governments and other political subdivisions that have enacted a stormwater 21 remediation fee under § 4–202.1 of the Environment Article.
- 22 Money expended from the Fund for the restoration of the Chesapeake [and (h) 23Atlantic Coastal Bays BAY and [their] ITS tributaries, including the Patuxent River, AND THE RESTORATION AND PROTECTION OF THE WATERS OF THE STATE is supplemental 24to and is not intended to take the place of funding that otherwise would be appropriated for [bay] restoration. 26
