A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County – Alcoholic Beverages – Tasting Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of creating in Anne Arundel County a CBWT cordial, beer, and wine
4 tasting (on-premises) license; specifying that the CBWT license may be issued
5 to certain persons; creating a license fee schedule for a CBWT license and
6 altering the fee schedule for a BWT beer and wine (on-premises) tasting license;
7 specifying certain limitations on the amount of alcoholic beverages that may be
8 offered for on-premises consumption; and generally relating to alcoholic
9 beverages licenses in Anne Arundel County.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

18 8-402.

19 (a) This section applies only in Anne Arundel County.

20 (b) In this section, “Board” means the Anne Arundel County Board of License
21 Commissioners.

1 (c) There is a Class **CBWT CORDIAL, BEER, AND WINE (ON-PREMISES)**
2 **TASTING LICENSE, A BWT beer and wine (on-premises) tasting license, and a WS**
3 **wine sampling (on-premises) license.**

4 (d) (1) **(I) A CLASS CBWT LICENSE MAY ONLY BE ISSUED TO A**
5 **HOLDER OF A CLASS BWL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR (ON-PREMISES) LICENSE.**

6 **(II) A Class BWT license may only be issued to a holder of a**
7 **Class BWL beer, wine and liquor (on-premises) license or a Class BW beer and wine**
8 **(on-sale) license.**

9 (2) The annual fee for a Class **CBWT OR BWT** license is:

10 [(i) \$50 for a holder of a Class BWL license; and

11 (ii) \$50 for a holder of a Class BW license.]

12 **(I) FOR A LICENSE THAT IS IN EFFECT FOR ANY 26 DAYS IN**
13 **A LICENSING PERIOD, \$125;**

14 **(II) FOR A LICENSE THAT IS IN EFFECT FOR ANY 52 DAYS IN**
15 **A LICENSING PERIOD, \$200; AND**

16 **(III) FOR A LICENSE THAT IS IN EFFECT FOR 365 DAYS IN A**
17 **LICENSING PERIOD, \$400.**

18 (3) The annual fee for a Class **CBWT OR BWT** license is in addition
19 to the Class BWL or BW annual fee.

20 **(4) A CLASS CBWT LICENSE AUTHORIZES A HOLDER TO PERMIT**
21 **THE ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION OF THE FOLLOWING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**
22 **FOR TASTING OR SAMPLING PURPOSES ONLY:**

23 **(I) CORDIALS TO BE SERVED IN A QUANTITY OF NOT MORE**
24 **THAN ONE-HALF OUNCE OF LIQUOR FROM EACH GIVEN BRAND TO ANY ONE**
25 **PERSON;**

26 **(II) LIGHT WINE TO BE SERVED IN A QUANTITY OF NOT**
27 **MORE THAN 1 OUNCE FROM EACH GIVEN BRAND TO ANY ONE PERSON; AND**

28 **(III) BEER TO BE SERVED IN A QUANTITY OF NOT MORE**
29 **THAN 3 OUNCES TO ANY ONE PERSON.**

1 ~~[(4)]~~(5) The Class BWT license authorizes a holder to permit the
2 on-premises consumption of the following alcoholic beverages for tasting or sampling
3 purposes only:

4 (i) Light wine to be served in a quantity of not more than 1
5 ounce from each given brand to any one person; and

6 (ii) Beer to be served in a quantity of not more than 3 ounces to
7 any one person.

8 (e) (1) The Board may issue a WS (wine sampling) license to bona fide
9 nonprofit organizations.

10 (2) The WS license authorizes the consumption of wine for tasting or
11 sampling purposes:

12 (i) On Class B beer and wine or beer, wine and liquor licensed
13 premises with the consent of the licensee; or

14 (ii) On premises without a permanent alcoholic beverages
15 license.

16 (3) The licensee may not serve more than 2 ounces from each brand to
17 any 1 person.

18 (4) The bona fide nonprofit organization:

19 (i) Shall apply for a WS license at least 15 days prior to the day
20 of issuance; and

21 (ii) May not be issued more than 12 WS licenses in any given
22 license year.

23 (5) The daily license fee is \$15.

24 (6) The WS licensee may bring wine onto Class B licensed premises for
25 sampling or tasting purposes only.

26 (f) The provisions of this section are not restricted by:

27 (1) The provisions in subsection (b) of § 12-107 of this article; and

28 (2) The provisions of law under § 9-102 of this article prohibiting the
29 issuance of 2 licenses for the same premises.

1 (g) In the City of Annapolis, the Mayor and City Council may approve the
2 issuance of a BWT license or a WS license. The fees for the licenses shall be set by the
3 Mayor and City Council.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 July 1, 2010.
