- 20 (B) IT IS THE POLICY OF THE STATE TO HAVE AT LEAST 25% OF STATE 21 EMPLOYEES PARTICIPATING IN A TELEWORK PROGRAM.
- 22 (C) (1) IF A STATE EMPLOYEE REQUESTS TO BECOME A 23 TELEWORKER, THE SUPERVISOR OF THE EMPLOYEE SHALL APPROVE THE

- 1 REQUEST OF THE EMPLOYEE TO TELEWORK UNLESS THE SUPERVISOR
- 2 DETERMINES THAT THE EMPLOYEE'S POSITION IS NOT SUITABLE FOR

- 4 (2) A SUPERVISOR WHO DENIES A STATE EMPLOYEE'S REQUEST
- 5 TO TELEWORK SHALL PROVIDE TO THE STATE EMPLOYEE A WRITTEN
- 6 DESCRIPTION OF THE FACTORS CONTRIBUTING TO THE SUPERVISOR'S DENIAL.
