Workers' Compensation – Occupational Disease Presumption – Duty Belt Worn by Law Enforcement

4 FOR the purpose of providing that certain paid police officers and certain paid deputy 5 sheriffs are presumed to be suffering from an occupational disease for a 6 lower-back impairment under the workers' compensation law under certain 7 circumstances; providing that the presumption shall apply only if the police officers 8 and deputy sheriffs subject to this Act have been employed for a certain period of 9 time and were required, as a condition of employment, to wear a certain duty belt; requiring that the presumption extends to the police officers and deputy sheriffs 10 11 subject to this Act for a certain period of time following a certain termination of 12 service; and generally relating to an occupational disease presumption under the 13 workers' compensation law for a lower-back impairment suffered by certain paid 14 police officers and paid deputy sheriffs required to wear a duty belt.

- 25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- [(e)](F) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, any paid
- 34 firefighter, paid fire fighting instructor, sworn member of the Office of the State Fire

- Marshal, paid police officer, paid law enforcement employee of the Department of Natural 1 2 Resources, deputy sheriff of Anne Arundel County, park police officer or employee of the 3 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, deputy sheriff of Montgomery 4 County, deputy sheriff of Baltimore City, Montgomery County correctional officer, deputy 5 sheriff of Prince George's County, or Prince George's County correctional officer who is 6 eligible for benefits under subsection (a), (b), (c), [or] (d), OR (E) of this section or the 7 dependents of those individuals shall receive the benefits in addition to any benefits that 8 the individual or the dependents of the individual are entitled to receive under the 9 retirement system in which the individual was a participant at the time of the claim.
- 10 (2) The benefits received under this title shall be adjusted so that the weekly total of those benefits and retirement benefits does not exceed the weekly salary that was paid to the paid law enforcement employee of the Department of Natural Resources, a park police officer or employee of the Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission, firefighter, fire fighting instructor, sworn member of the Office of the State Fire Marshal, police officer, deputy sheriff, or Prince George's County or Montgomery County correctional officer.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2015.
