## A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Managed Care Organizations and Health Insurance Carriers – Prior Authorization for HIV Postexposure Prophylaxis for Victims of Sexual Offenses Prohibition

FOR the purpose of prohibiting managed care organizations and certain insurers, nonprofit
health service plans, and health maintenance organizations from applying a prior
authorization requirement for prescription drugs used as postexposure prophylaxis
for the prevention of HIV if the drug is prescribed to a victim of an alleged rape or
sexual offense; and generally relating to prescription drugs used as postexposure
prophylaxis for the prevention of HIV infection and prior authorizations.

(A) (1) **THIS SECTION APPLIES TO:** 12

INSURERS AND NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS THAT 13 **(I)** 14 PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR PRESCRIPTION DRUGS UNDER INDIVIDUAL, GROUP, OR 15BLANKET HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES OR CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR 16 **DELIVERED IN THE STATE; AND** 

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17**(II)** HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE 18 COVERAGE FOR PRESCRIPTION DRUGS UNDER INDIVIDUAL OR GROUP CONTRACTS 19 THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE.

20AN INSURER, A NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN, OR A HEALTH (2) 21MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION THAT PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR PRESCRIPTION 22DRUGS THROUGH A PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGER IS SUBJECT TO THE 23**REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.** 

24**(B)** AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION MAY NOT APPLY A PRIOR 25AUTHORIZATION REQUIREMENT FOR Α PRESCRIPTION DRUG USED AS 26POSTEXPOSURE PROPHYLAXIS FOR THE PREVENTION OF HIV IF THE 27PRESCRIPTION DRUG IS PRESCRIBED TO A VICTIM OF AN ALLEGED RAPE OR SEXUAL 28**OFFENSE.** 

29SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all 30 policies, contracts, and health benefit plans issued, delivered, or renewed in the State on or after January 1, 2023. 31

32 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

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1 January 1, 2023.
