BY adding to Article - Transportation Section 13–619.3 Annotated Code of Maryland (2009 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article – Transportation** 13-619.3.
