4 5 6	FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Housing and Community Development to provide one—time grants to certain counties, to be used to expand affordable housing and generally relating to affordable housing.
7 8	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND That:
9	(a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
10	(2) "County" means a county of the State or Baltimore City.
11 12	(3) "Department" means the Department of Housing and Community Development.
13 14 15	(b) For fiscal year 2024, the Governor shall include in the annual budget bill as appropriation of \$60,000,000 to the Department, to provide one—time grants to the thre counties with the highest cost of living.
16 17 18	(c) The Department shall develop a formula to allocate the funds to the selecter counties based on the relative percentage difference between the cost of living in the selected counties.
19	(d) Counties shall use the funds provided under this Act to:
20	(1) expand and supplement existing housing programs;
21	(2) increase affordability along targeted corridors;

1 (3) build new affordable housing for low and moderate income households; 2 (4) fund down payment and first-time buyer assistance programs; or 3 fund any other housing program selected by the county. (5)4 (1) On or before December 1, 2024, the counties receiving funds under this (e) Act shall report to the Department and, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State 5 6 Government Article, the General Assembly on the use and expected impact of the allocated 7 funds. The Department shall make the reports publicly available on the 8 (2) 9 Department's website. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 11 October 1, 2022.
