## 25 Article – General Provisions

1 **7–505.** 

- 2 (A) THE GOVERNOR SHALL ANNUALLY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF 3 SEPTEMBER AS SICKLE CELL ANEMIA AWARENESS MONTH IN RECOGNITION OF 4 THE NEED FOR INCREASED AWARENESS OF SICKLE CELL DISEASE.
- 5 (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND PUBLIC HEALTH 6 ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE SICKLE CELL ANEMIA AWARENESS MONTH 7 PROPERLY WITH APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, EVENTS, AND ACTIVITIES.
- 8 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 9 1, 2022.
