A BILL ENTITLED

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Natalie M. La Prade Medical Cannabis Commission - Definitions

FOR the purpose of defining "bona fide provider—patient relationship" for the purposes of certain provisions of law governing medical cannabis to mean a treatment or counseling relationship between a provider and a patient in which the provider has reviewed certain records and completed a certain assessment in person or through telehealth, has created and maintained certain records, and has a certain reasonable expectation; defining "telehealth" for the purposes of certain provisions of law governing medical cannabis; and generally relating to medical cannabis.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 20 (B) "BONA FIDE PROVIDER-PATIENT RELATIONSHIP" MEANS A TREATMENT 21 OR COUNSELING RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN A PROVIDER AND A PATIENT IN WHICH 22 THE PROVIDER HAS:
- 23 (1) REVIEWED THE PATIENT'S RELEVANT MEDICAL RECORDS AND

1 2	COMPLETED AN ASSESSMENT OF THE PATIENT'S MEDICAL HISTORY AND CURRENT MEDICAL CONDITION:
3	(I) IN PERSON; OR
4 5 6	(II) IF THE PATIENT OR CAREGIVER HAS A HARDSHIP PREVENTING AN IN-PERSON ASSESSMENT, AS DETERMINED BY THE PROVIDER, THROUGH TELEHEALTH;
7 8	(2) CREATED AND MAINTAINED RECORDS OF THE PATIENT'S CONDITION IN ACCORDANCE WITH MEDICALLY ACCEPTED STANDARDS; AND
9 10 11	(3) A REASONABLE EXPECTATION THAT THE PROVIDER WILL MONITOR THE PROGRESS OF THE PATIENT WHILE USING MEDICAL CANNABIS AND TAKE ANY MEDICALLY INDICATED ACTION:
12	(I) TO PROVIDE FOLLOW-UP CARE TO THE PATIENT;
13 14 15	(II) REGARDING THE EFFICACY OF THE USE OF MEDICAL CANNABIS AS A TREATMENT OF THE PATIENT'S SEVERE OR DEBILITATING MEDICAL CONDITION; AND
16 17	(III) REGARDING ANY ADVERSE EVENT ASSOCIATED WITH THE USE OF MEDICAL CANNABIS.
18	[(b)] (C) "Caregiver" means:
19 20	(1) A person who has agreed to assist with a qualifying patient's medical use of cannabis; and
21 22	(2) For a qualifying patient under the age of 18 years, a parent or legal guardian.
23	[(c)] (D) "Certifying provider" means an individual who:
24 25 26	(1) (i) 1. Has an active, unrestricted license to practice medicine that was issued by the State Board of Physicians under Title 14 of the Health Occupations Article; and
27	2. Is in good standing with the State Board of Physicians;
28 29 30	(ii) 1. Has an active, unrestricted license to practice dentistry that was issued by the State Board of Dental Examiners under Title 4 of the Health Occupations Article; and

1 2	2. Is in good standing with the State Board of Dental Examiners;
3 4 5	(iii) 1. Has an active, unrestricted license to practice podiatry that was issued by the State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners under Title 16 of the Health Occupations Article; and
6 7	2. Is in good standing with the State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners; or
8 9 10 11	(iv) 1. Has an active, unrestricted license to practice registered nursing and has an active, unrestricted certification to practice as a nurse practitioner or a nurse midwife that were issued by the State Board of Nursing under Title 8 of the Health Occupations Article; and
2	2. Is in good standing with the State Board of Nursing;
13	(2) Has a State controlled dangerous substances registration; and
14 15	(3) Is registered with the Commission to make cannabis available to patients for medical use in accordance with regulations adopted by the Commission.
16 17	[(d)] (E) "Commission" means the Natalie M. LaPrade Medical Cannabis Commission established under this subtitle.
18 19 20 21	[(e)] (F) "Dispensary" means an entity licensed under this subtitle that acquires, possesses, processes, transfers, transports, sells, distributes, dispenses, or administers cannabis, products containing cannabis, related supplies, related products containing cannabis including food, tinctures, aerosols, oils, or ointments, or educational materials for use by a qualifying patient or caregiver.
23 24	[(f)] (G) "Dispensary agent" means an owner, a member, an employee, a volunteer, an officer, or a director of a dispensary.
25 26	[(g)] (H) "Fund" means the Natalie M. LaPrade Medical Cannabis Commission Fund established under § 13–3303 of this subtitle.
27	[(h)] (I) "Grower" means an entity licensed under this subtitle that:
28 29	(1) (i) Cultivates, manufactures, processes, packages, or dispenses medical cannabis; or
30	(ii) Processes medical cannabis products; and
31 32	(2) Is authorized by the Commission to provide cannabis to a qualifying patient, caregiver, processor, dispensary, or independent testing laboratory.

- [(i)] (J) "Independent testing laboratory" means a facility, an entity, or a site that offers or performs tests related to the inspection and testing of cannabis and products containing cannabis.
- 4 **[**(j)**] (K)** "Medical cannabis grower agent" means an owner, an employee, a volunteer, an officer, or a director of a grower.
- 6 [(k)] (L) "Processor" means an entity that:
- 7 (1) Transforms medical cannabis into another product or extract; and
- 8 (2) Packages and labels medical cannabis.
- 9 **[**(l)**] (M)** "Processor agent" means an owner, a member, an employee, a 10 volunteer, an officer, or a director of a processor.
- [(m)] (N) "Qualifying patient" means an individual who:
- 12 (1) Has been provided with a written certification by a certifying provider 13 in accordance with a bona fide provider—patient relationship; and
- 14 (2) If under the age of 18 years, has a caregiver.
- 15 (O) "TELEHEALTH" MEANS THE USE OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGIES FOR THE EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION FROM ONE SITE TO ANOTHER FOR THE PROVISION OF HEALTH CARE TO A PATIENT FROM A PROVIDER THROUGH HARDWIRE OR INTERNET CONNECTION.
- 19 [(n)] (P) "Written certification" means a certification that:
- 20 (1) Is issued by a certifying provider to a qualifying patient with whom the 21 provider has a bona fide provider—patient relationship; and
- 22 (2) Includes a written statement certifying that, in the provider's professional opinion, after having completed an assessment of the patient's medical history and current medical condition, the patient has a condition:
- 25 (i) That meets the inclusion criteria and does not meet the exclusion 26 criteria of the certifying provider's application; and
- 27 (ii) For which the potential benefits of the medical use of cannabis would likely outweigh the health risks for the patient; and
- 29 (3) May include a written statement certifying that, in the provider's 30 professional opinion, a 30-day supply of medical cannabis would be inadequate to meet the 31 medical needs of the qualifying patient.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2018.
