Green Schools - Model Professional Development Facilities - Designation

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources, in collaboration with 4 the State Department of Education and in consultation with other relevant parties, 5 to establish criteria for designating green schools in the State as model professional 6 development facilities; requiring the Maryland Association of Environmental and 7 Outdoor Education to use a certain appropriation to update its recertification 8 application on or before a certain date; requiring the State Department of Education to designate the Maryland Association of Environmental and Outdoor Education to 9 10 determine whether a school meets the criteria established for the designation of a 11 model professional development facility; and generally relating to green schools.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 5 (I) A SCHOOL'S EXPERIENCE PROVIDING GUIDANCE TO
- 6 EDUCATORS AND SCHOOLS ON HOW TO TRANSITION THEIR SCHOOL TO A GREEN
