2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2008 – Prince George’s County**
3 **– Forest Heights Municipal Building**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2008
5 to remove the requirement that the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of
6 Forest Heights provide a certain matching fund.

8 Chapter 336 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2008
9 Section 1(3) Item ZA01(BY) and ZA02(BI)

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 June 1, 2010.
