A BILL ENTITLED

Distribution of Marriage Ceremony Fees

3 FOR the purpose of making the fee for the performance of a marriage ceremony by a clerk 4 or deputy clerk of the circuit court for a county nonrefundable and payable before a $\mathbf{5}$ certain license is issued; reducing, in a certain county, the fee for the performance of 6 a marriage ceremony; altering a requirement that the clerks retain and distribute 7 certain fees in a certain manner; requiring that the clerks pay certain fees to the 8 State Comptroller; requiring the State Comptroller to distribute certain fees in a 9 certain manner; requiring the recipient of certain fees to use the fees in a certain manner and report annually on the use of the fees; authorizing the State Comptroller 1011 and the Maryland Historical Trust to request certain financial statements or an 12audit of certain financial records; repealing certain reporting requirements; 13 requiring the State Comptroller, under certain circumstances, to withhold the payment of certain fees; making technical corrections; and generally relating to the 14 distribution of fees for the performance of a marriage ceremony. 15
