CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

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Maryland Veterans Service Animal Program – Therapy Horses

- FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "nonprofit training entity" for the purposes of 4 the Maryland Veterans Service Animal Program to include an entity that uses trained therapy horses for interaction with veterans; altering the duties of a nonprofit training entity selected under the Program; altering the circumstances under which a nonprofit training entity is authorized to disqualify a Program participant from participation in the Program; altering a certain definition; and generally relating to therapy horses and the Maryland Veterans Service Animal Program.
