5 FOR the purpose of establishing that the State Board of Heating, Ventilation,
6 Air-Conditioning, and Refrigeration Contractors exercises its powers, duties, and
7 functions subject to the authority of the Secretary of Labor, Licensing, and
8 Regulation; and generally relating to the State Board of Heating, Ventilation,
9 Air-Conditioning, and Refrigeration Contractors.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Business Regulation**
