- 3 FOR the purpose of specifying the filing period for a renewal of an alcoholic beverages 4 license in Washington County; requiring a license holder to file an application to $\mathbf{5}$ renew an annual license and the required documents by a certain date; altering the 6 penalty for late filing of an application for a license renewal; prohibiting the 7 Washington County Board of License Commissioners from renewing a license until 8 the license holder pays certain taxes by a certain date and submits a certain 9 certificate to the Board; specifying certain content of a license renewal application; authorizing the Board to issue renewed licenses for the following year during a 10 11 certain time period; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Washington 12County.
