1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Agriculture – Young Farmers Advisory Board – Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Young Farmers Advisory Board;
4 making stylistic changes; and generally relating to the membership of the Young
5 Farmers Advisory Board.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Agriculture**

14 2–1002.

15 (a) The Young Farmers Advisory Board shall consist of [12] **20** members
16 appointed by the Governor.

17 (b) Of the [12] **20** members:

- 1 (1) [One] 1 shall be from the Department of Agriculture;
- 2 (2) [One] 1 shall be from the Department of Economic Competitiveness and
3 Commerce;
- 4 (3) [One] 1 shall be from the Forestry Program within the Department of
5 Natural Resources;
- 6 (4) 1 SHALL BE AN OFFICER OF THE MARYLAND FFA ASSOCIATION;
- 7 (5) 1 SHALL BE AN URBAN FARMER;
- 8 [(4)] (6) [One] 1 shall be from the Maryland Farm Bureau; and
- 9 [(5)] (7) [Eight] 14 shall be appointed from the general public.

10 (c) To the extent practicable, the Governor shall attempt to ensure regional
11 diversity among the members of the Advisory Board appointed from the general public.

12 (d) Each member from the general public shall:

- 13 (1) Be interested in the preservation and development of agriculture and
14 preservation of the agricultural way of life in Maryland;
- 15 (2) Be under the age of 45 years at the beginning of the member's term;
- 16 (3) Derive at least 50% of the member's personal income from farming or
17 agricultural activities in the State; and
- 18 (4) Be a resident of the State.

19 (e) (1) Except for the initial terms of the Advisory Board, the term of a member
20 shall be 3 years.

21 (2) (i) The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms
22 provided for members of the Advisory Board on October 1, 2004.

23 (ii) The terms of the initial members shall be staggered evenly
24 between 2 years and 3 years as the Advisory Board shall determine at the Board's first
25 meeting.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
27 1, 2016.
