2 **Baltimore City – Alcoholic Beverages – Transfer of License**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the transfer of ~~one certain~~ Class B–D–7 alcoholic
4 beverages ~~license from a certain block~~ licenses from certain blocks in Baltimore
5 City to ~~another block~~ other blocks in Baltimore City; make a stylistic change;
6 and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Baltimore City.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

15 9–204.

16 (a) **[In] EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, IN**
17 **Baltimore City, within the area bounded by Twenty–Fifth (25th) Street on the north**

1 and Centre Street on the south and Howard Street on the west and Guilford Avenue
 2 on the east, no new licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages shall be issued except
 3 Class B licenses and no licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages of any class shall be
 4 transferred into this area of Baltimore City.

5 (b) The Board of License Commissioners of Baltimore City may not authorize
 6 the issuance of a special amusement license to the holder of a Class D beer, wine and
 7 liquor license in such area of Baltimore City.

8 (c) One new license may be issued to the area bounded on the north by
 9 Oliver Street, on the east by Charles Street, on the south by Mount Royal, and on the
 10 west by Maryland Avenue.

11 (d) One new license may be issued in the area bounded by Oliver Street on
 12 the north, Mount Royal Avenue on the west and south, and Maryland Avenue on the
 13 east.

14 (e) One new license may be issued for a nonprofit concert facility in the area
 15 bounded on the south by Preston Street, on the east by Cathedral Street, and on the
 16 west by Park Avenue.

17 **(F) ONE CLASS B-D-7 LICENSE MAY BE TRANSFERRED FROM THE 400**
 18 **BLOCK OF EAST BIDDLE STREET TO THE UNIT BLOCK OF WEST NORTH**
 19 **AVENUE.**

20 **(G) ONE CLASS B-D-7 LICENSE MAY BE TRANSFERRED FROM THE 900**
 21 **BLOCK TO THE 1700 BLOCK OF NORTH CHARLES STREET.**

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 23 July 1, 2014.
