- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 17 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 18 MEANINGS INDICATED.
- 19 (2) "BODY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 5–101 OF THE 20 HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE.
- 21 (3) (I) "MORTUARY SCIENCE PRACTITIONER" MEANS A 22 PERSON WHO IS LICENSED BY THE STATE AS A FUNERAL DIRECTOR.

- 3 (II) "MORTUARY SCIENCE PRACTITIONER" INCLUDES A

- 9 (II) A POLICE FORCE OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL 10 CORPORATION OF THE STATE.
- 11 (B) ON REQUEST OF A MORTUARY SCIENCE PRACTITIONER, A POLICE
- 12 OFFICER CALLED TO A RESIDENCE WHERE AN INDIVIDUAL HAS DIED SHALL
- 13 REMAIN AT THE RESIDENCE UNTIL THE BODY IS REMOVED FROM THE
- 14 RESIDENCE BY THE MORTUARY SCIENCE PRACTITIONER OR MEDICAL
