16	(A) The Department may not accept articles of revival for record unless:
17	(1) [All] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION,
18	ALL annual reports required to be filed by the corporation or which would have been
19	required if the charter had not been forfeited are filed; and

Unemployment insurance contributions, or reimbursement payments,

all State and local taxes, except taxes on real estate, and all interest and penalties due by

the corporation or which would have become due if the charter had not been forfeited are

- 5 MOST RECENTLY DUE ANNUAL REPORTS REQUIRED TO BE FILED BY THE
- 6 CORPORATION OR WHICH WOULD HAVE BEEN REQUIRED IF THE CHARTER HAD NOT
- 7 BEEN FORFEITED.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 9 October 1, 2022.
