- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

free or reduced price meals for the prior fiscal year.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 June 1, 2014, and shall be applicable beginning in the 2014–2015 school year.

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
