A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Courts – Dangerous Dog Presumption – Specific Breed Prohibition**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing that, for the purpose of determining criminal or civil
4 liability, a dog may not be presumed dangerous or potentially dangerous solely
5 on the basis of the breed or heritage of the dog; providing that this Act does not
6 preclude a political subdivision from adopting or enforcing a program to control
7 dangerous or potentially dangerous dogs, provided that no program may
8 discriminate among dogs solely on the basis of the breed or heritage of the dog;
9 providing for the application of this Act; making this Act an emergency
10 measure; and generally relating to dogs.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

19 **10–922.**

20 **(A) FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING CRIMINAL OR CIVIL**
21 **LIABILITY, A DOG MAY NOT BE PRESUMED DANGEROUS OR POTENTIALLY**
22 **DANGEROUS SOLELY ON THE BASIS OF THE BREED OR HERITAGE OF THE DOG.**

23 **(B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PRECLUDE A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION**
24 **FROM ADOPTING OR ENFORCING A PROGRAM TO CONTROL DANGEROUS OR**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS DOGS IF THE PROGRAM DOES NOT DISCRIMINATE**
2 **AMONG DOGS SOLELY ON THE BASIS OF THE BREED OR HERITAGE OF THE DOG.**

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
4 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have
5 any effect on or application to any cause of action arising before the effective date of
6 this Act.

7 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
8 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
9 has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
10 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
11 the date it is enacted.
