- A CONTRACT MAY CONTAIN A PROVISION FOR THE PAYMENT OF LEGAL
- 20 FEES BY THE LOSING PARTY IN A LEGAL ACTION INVOLVING THE PARTIES TO
- 21 THE CONTRACT ONLY IF THE PROVISION IS EQUALLY APPLICABLE TO BOTH
- 22 PARTIES TO THE CONTRACT.
