A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Legislative Districting – Resident Delegate for Each County**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring an advisory committee established by the Governor after
4 a decennial census to formulate a legislative districting plan for the election of
5 members of the General Assembly that, to the greatest extent practicable,
6 draws the lines for the districts so that each county in the State has at least one
7 resident delegate; and generally relating to legislative districting and a resident
8 delegate for each county.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – State Government**

17 **2–203.**

18 **AFTER A DECENNIAL CENSUS, ON ESTABLISHMENT BY THE GOVERNOR OF**
19 **AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO FORMULATE A LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTING PLAN**
20 **FOR THE ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE ADVISORY**
21 **COMMITTEE SHALL, TO THE GREATEST EXTENT PRACTICABLE, DRAW THE LINES**
22 **FOR THE DISTRICTS SO THAT EACH COUNTY IN THE STATE HAS AT LEAST ONE**
23 **RESIDENT DELEGATE.**

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 June 1, 2011.
