1 AN ACT concerning

State Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors – Cease and Desist Orders and Injunctive Relief – Authority

FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors to
issue a <u>public</u> cease and desist order or obtain injunctive relief <u>impose a civil fine of</u>
<u>no more than a certain amount</u> for certain violations of certain provisions of law
<u>under certain circumstances</u>; making a technical correction <u>providing that each</u>
<u>violation of certain provisions of law is a separate offense under certain</u>
<u>circumstances</u>; and generally relating to the State Board of Morticians and Funeral
Directors.

<u>Except as otherwise provided in this title, a person may not practice, attempt to</u>
 <u>practice, offer to practice, or assist in the practice of mortuary science in this State unless</u>
 <u>licensed by the Board.</u>

19(C)THE BOARD MAY NOT ISSUE A PUBLIC CEASE AND DESIST ORDER TO A20FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT THAT WAS PREVIOUSLY LICENSED BY THE BOARD.
