### 1 AN ACT concerning

## Criminal Law – Life–Threatening Injury Involving a Motor Vehicle or Vessel - Criminal Negligence (Wade's Law)

# FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from driving, operating, or controlling a motor vehicle or vessel in a criminally negligent manner that results in a life-threatening injury to another; providing that certain conduct does not constitute a violation of this Act; establishing penalties for a violation of this Act; defining certain terms; and

### 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 **3–212.1.**
- 19 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "VESSEL" MEANS ANY WATERCRAFT THAT IS

(2) "VESSEL" DOES NOT INCLUDE A SEAPLANE.

4 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT CAUSE A LIFE-THREATENING INJURY TO ANOTHER 5 AS A RESULT OF THE PERSON'S DRIVING, OPERATING, OR CONTROLLING A MOTOR 6 VEHICLE OR VESSEL IN A CRIMINALLY NEGLIGENT MANNER.

7 (C) FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON ACTS IN A CRIMINALLY
 8 NEGLIGENT MANNER WITH RESPECT TO A RESULT OR A CIRCUMSTANCE WHEN:

9 (1) THE PERSON SHOULD BE AWARE, BUT FAILS TO PERCEIVE, THAT 10 THE PERSON'S CONDUCT CREATES A SUBSTANTIAL AND UNJUSTIFIABLE RISK THAT 11 SUCH A RESULT WILL OCCUR; AND

12 (2) THE FAILURE TO PERCEIVE CONSTITUTES A GROSS DEVIATION 13 FROM THE STANDARD OF CARE THAT WOULD BE EXERCISED BY A REASONABLE 14 PERSON.

(D) IT IS NOT A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION FOR A PERSON TO CAUSE A
LIFE-THREATENING INJURY TO ANOTHER AS A RESULT OF THE PERSON'S DRIVING,
OPERATING, OR CONTROLLING A MOTOR VEHICLE OR VESSEL IN A NEGLIGENT
MANNER.

19 (E) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR 20 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 18 MONTHS 21 OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR BOTH.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 October 1, 2021.
