CHAPTER
AN ACT concerning
State Retirement and Pension System - Board of Trustees - Oath
FOR the purpose of altering the number of days after the appointment or election of an individual to the Board of Trustees for the State Retirement and Pension System during which the individual is required to take a certain oath; repealing the requirement that individuals appointed or elected to the Board of Trustees take a certain oath; clarifying that individuals appointed or elected to the Board of Trustee take a certain oath required by a certain provision of the Maryland Constitution requiring the oath to be taken before a clerk or deputy clerk of a circuit court providing for the chairman of the Board of Trustees; making a conforming change and generally relating to the Board of Trustees for the State Retirement and Pension System.
BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – State Personnel and Pensions
