14 15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 19	(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
20	(2) "HEAVY-DUTY VEHICLE" MEANS A VEHICLE WITH A GROSS



- 1 (3) "MEDIUM-DUTY VEHICLE" MEANS A VEHICLE WITH A GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING OF NOT LESS THAN 10,000 POUNDS AND NOT MORE THAN 26,000 POUNDS.
- 4 (B) (1) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2023, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL 5 ADOPT REGULATIONS ESTABLISHING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SALE OF NEW 6 ZERO-EMISSION MEDIUM- AND HEAVY-DUTY VEHICLES IN THE STATE.
- 7 (2) THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS 8 SUBSECTION MAY:
- 9 (I) UPDATE EXISTING REGULATIONS; AND
- 10 (II) INCORPORATE BY REFERENCE THE CALIFORNIA AIR
  11 RESOURCES BOARD'S VEHICLE STANDARDS, AS REVISED AND UPDATED.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2023.
