AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any incinerator in existence for which all necessary permits for construction, modification, operation, or use have been issued before the effective date of this Act. If the construction, modification, operation, or use of an incinerator is allowed to continue in accordance with this section:

22	(2) if abandoned, the use may not be resumed.
