- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 11
- 12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15–151. 14
- (A) UNLESS THE CHILD'S FAMILY HAS REQUESTED THAT THE CHILD BE 15
- REMOVED, A CHILD ON THE REGISTRY FOR THE AUTISM WAIVER SHALL REMAIN ON 16
- THE REGISTRY IF THE CHILD'S FAMILY RELOCATES OUT OF THE STATE FOR 17
- 18 MILITARY SERVICE.
- IF A CHILD ON THE REGISTRY FOR THE AUTISM WAIVER BECOMES 19
- 20 ELIGIBLE FOR SERVICES THROUGH THE WAIVER WHILE THE CHILD'S FAMILY IS OUT
- 21OF THE STATE FOR MILITARY SERVICE, THE CHILD SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR
- 22 SERVICES THROUGH THE WAIVER IF THE FAMILY RELOCATES TO THE STATE.
