- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City to require a licensee to close to the public the entire operation of 4 the premises for not less than a certain number of days under certain $\mathbf{5}$ 6 circumstances; prohibiting the appeal of a certain closure prohibiting the Board 7of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City or a court from staying an 8 order to revoke an alcoholic beverages license until a certain number of days 9 after a license is revoked; providing that a person whose license revocation by 10 the Board is subsequently overturned on appeal is entitled to reimbursement for lost wages as a result of a certain prohibition; prohibiting a person whose 11 license has been revoked by the Board from giving, serving, dispensing, keeping, 12or allowing to be consumed any alcoholic beverages until certain circumstances 13 14 occur; and generally relating to the revocation of an alcoholic beverages license 15in Baltimore City.
