Real Property - Senior Apartment Facilities - Conversion

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a landlord to provide written notice to a certain tenant at 4 least a certain number of days before converting a senior apartment facility into an 5 apartment facility for the general population; specifying the contents of the written 6 notice; requiring a landlord to allow a certain tenant to terminate the tenant's lease 7 after giving at least 1 month's written notice to the landlord, notwithstanding the 8 terms of the lease; prohibiting a landlord from withholding any portion of a certain 9 tenant's security deposit for a certain purpose; requiring a landlord to reimburse the 10 moving expenses of a certain tenant, up to a certain amount and under certain circumstances: authorizing the Secretary of Housing and Community Development 11 to adopt regulations necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act; authorizing the 12 Secretary to impose a certain civil penalty for violations of this Act, beginning on a 13 eertain date; providing for the enforcement of certain provisions of this Act by the 14 15 Division of Consumer Protection of the Office of the Attorney General; providing for the enforcement of this Act by each unit of the State; defining certain terms; and 16 17 generally relating to senior apartment facilities.
