1 AN ACT concerning

Hunting and Fishing Licenses – Active Military, Former Prisoners of War, Recipients of the Purple Heart Award, and Disabled Veterans

FOR the purpose of repealing a requirement that the Department of Natural Resources
submit a certain report to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a
certain date; repealing the termination provision for certain provisions of law
relating to the issuance of complimentary or discounted hunting and fishing licenses
to certain military personnel, former prisoners of war, recipients of the Purple Heart
Award, and disabled veterans; and generally relating to hunting and fishing licenses.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

ISECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 31,
 2019, the Department of Natural Resources shall report to the Governor and, in accordance
 with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly on:

(1) the number of discounted angler's licenses and trout stamps,
 Chesapeake Bay and coastal sport fishing licenses, and hunting licenses and associated

3 (2) the number and identity of any other states that have enacted 4 legislation authorizing the issuance of a lifetime complimentary angler's license, a 5 recreational salt water sport fishing license, or a hunting license to a Maryland resident 6 who certifies that the resident is a former prisoner of war or a 100% service connected 7 disabled veteran;

8 (3) the total number of complimentary angler's licenses, recreational salt 9 water sport fishing licenses, and hunting licenses issued to Maryland residents under the 10 legislation; and

11 (4) the total number of complimentary angler's licenses, Chesapeake Bay 12 and coastal sport fishing licenses, and hunting licenses issued by the Department to 13 out-of-state persons under this Act and § 10-303(a)(2)(ii) of the Natural Resources Article.]

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 15 1, 2017. [It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 2020, 16 with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and 17 of no further force and effect.]
