

## Chapter 107

**(Senate Bill 297)**

AN ACT concerning

**State Board for Professional Engineers – Engineer Members – Qualifications**

FOR the purpose of reducing the number of years that an engineer member of the State Board for Professional Engineers must have practiced engineering; and generally relating to the State Board for Professional Engineers.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – Business Occupations and Professions**

14–201.

There is a State Board for Professional Engineers in the Department.

14–202.

(c) (1) Each engineer member of the Board shall have:

(i) practiced engineering for at least [12] ~~5~~ 10 years; and

(ii) been in responsible charge of important engineering work for at least 5 years.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
