1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 3–1001 of Article – Education of the Annotated Code of
3 Maryland be repealed.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland

17 BUREAU OF THE CENSUS AND AS REVIEWED AND CORRECTED BY THE
18 DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING.

20 EDUCATION DISTRICTS, CENSUS TRACT AND BLOCK NUMBERS, AS INDICATED IN
21 THE P.L. 94–171 DATA OR SHOWN ON THE P.L. 94–171 CENSUS BLOCK MAPS
22 PROVIDED BY THE U.S. BUREAU OF THE CENSUS AND REFERRED TO IN THIS
23 SUBTITLE, ARE USED TO DEFINE THE BOUNDARIES OF BOARD OF EDUCATION

2 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
3 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
4 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
5 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
6 the date it is enacted.
