## Motor Vehicle Registration - Exception for Golf Carts - City of Crisfield

- 3 FOR the purpose of creating an exception from motor vehicle registration requirements 4 under certain circumstances for golf carts in the City of Crisfield; providing that a 5 person who operates a golf cart on a highway in the City of Crisfield may operate the 6 golf cart only on certain roads at certain times and only if the golf cart is equipped 7 with certain lighting devices; requiring a person who operates a golf cart on a 8 highway in the City of Crisfield to keep as far to the right of the roadway as feasible; 9 and generally relating to an exception to motor vehicle registration requirements for golf carts in the City of Crisfield. 10
