- 18 (A) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL INSTALL AND MAINTAIN A VIDEO
- 19 SURVEILLANCE CAMERA SYSTEM IN EACH OF THE STATE FACILITIES UNDER
- 20 THE DIRECTION OF THE ADMINISTRATION.
- 21 (B) ANY VIDEO SURVEILLANCE CAMERA SYSTEM INSTALLED AND
