A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Motor Vehicle Registration – Exception for Golf Carts – Hoopers Island and Taylors Island

4 FOR the purpose of creating an exception from motor vehicle registration requirements 5 under certain circumstances for golf carts on Upper Hoopers Island, Middle Hoopers 6 Island, or Taylors Island; providing that a person who operates a golf cart on a 7 highway on Upper Hoopers Island, Middle Hoopers Island, or Taylors Island may operate the golf cart only on certain roads at certain times and only if the golf cart is 8 9 equipped with certain lighting devices; requiring a person who operates a golf cart 10 on a highway on Upper Hoopers Island, Middle Hoopers Island, or Taylors Island to 11 keep as far to the right as feasible and possess a valid driver's license; authorizing 12 the County Council of Dorchester County to designate highways on which a person 13 may operate a golf cart on Upper Hoopers Island, Middle Hoopers Island, or Taylors 14 Island; and generally relating to an exception to motor vehicle registration requirements for golf carts on Upper Hoopers Island, Middle Hoopers Island, or 15 16 Taylors Island.
