## Public Schools - Health Education - Gambling Dangers and Addiction

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education, on or before a certain date, to develop a certain program of education on the dangers of gambling and 4 5 gambling addiction; requiring the program to be coordinated with other State 6 agencies responsible for gambling addiction education and control; requiring a 7 county board of education to require each public middle and high school in the county 8 to include instruction on gambling dangers and addiction in certain grades, 9 beginning in a certain school year and annually thereafter; authorizing the State Board of Education to adopt regulations to implement this Act; and generally 10 11 relating to education on the dangers of gambling and gambling addiction for students 12 in public schools.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article Education
- 21 **7–446.**
- 22 (A) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2021, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP A
- 23 PROGRAM OF EDUCATION ON THE DANGERS OF GAMBLING AND GAMBLING
- 24 ADDICTION TO BE PROVIDED IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.



- 1 (B) THE GAMBLING DANGERS AND ADDICTION EDUCATION PROGRAM
  2 SHALL BE COORDINATED WITH OTHER STATE AGENCIES THAT ARE RESPONSIBLE
  3 FOR GAMBLING ADDICTION EDUCATION AND CONTROL, INCLUDING THE
  4 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH ADMINISTRATION OF THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF
  5 HEALTH.
- 6 (C) ANNUALLY, BEGINNING IN THE 2021–2022 SCHOOL YEAR, A COUNTY BOARD SHALL REQUIRE EACH PUBLIC MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY TO INCLUDE INSTRUCTION ON THE DANGERS OF GAMBLING AND GAMBLING ADDICTION IN GRADES 6 THROUGH 12.
- 10 **(D)** THE STATE BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE 11 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
