- 20 On written request of any other entity, the appropriate advisory body 21 may issue an advisory opinion.

- 1 **(B) (1)** THE APPROPRIATE ADVISORY BODY MAY ISSUE INFORMAL 2 ADVICE INSTEAD OF AN ADVISORY OPINION.
- 3 (2) Information related to informal advice provided under This subsection shall remain confidential and is not subject to the Requirements of § 5–303 of this subtitle.
