- 5 (a) [All] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION,
 6 ALL inspections of funeral establishments shall be unannounced and may take place
 7 at any time without notice from the Board.
- 8 (b) An unannounced inspection may include advance notice that [an 9 investigator] A BOARD MEMBER OR BOARD EMPLOYEE may be in the region of the funeral establishment FOR PURPOSES OF CONDUCTING AN INSPECTION, if:
