## Department of Transportation and Department of the Environment - Purple Line Tree Replacement Plan - Urban Tree Program - Establishment

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Transportation, in conjunction with the 4 Department of the Environment, to develop a plan an urban tree program to replace  $\mathbf{5}$ trees that are removed during the construction of the Purple Line certain 6 7 transportation projects; requiring the Department of Transportation to consult with 8 certain entities and individuals in developing the <del>plan</del> program; requiring the <del>plan</del> 9 program to provide for the replacement of trees in certain communities and prioritize the initial replacement of trees in certain communities; authorizing the replacement 10 of trees on certain types of property; requiring the Department of Transportation, in 11 12collaboration with the Department of the Environment, the Department of Natural 13 Resources, and certain other State agencies, to identify available sources of funding 14for replacing trees in accordance with this Act; providing for the construction of this
