Calvert County - Alcoholic Beverages - Bottle Clubs - Prohibited

- FOR the purpose of defining a "bottle club" bottle club in Calvert County to mean eertain 3 establishments where certain persons undertake certain activities under certain 4 5 circumstances: prohibiting a person from operating a bottle club in the county; 6 prohibiting certain activities with respect to alcoholic beverages at a bottle club in 7 the county; providing that certain entities may not be considered a bottle club for certain purposes under certain conditions; providing a certain penalty for a violation 8 9 of this Act; making this Act an emergency measure; an establishment that is a 10 certain type of restaurant or nightclub; prohibiting a bottle club in the county from 11 giving, serving, dispensing, keeping, or allowing to be consumed on its premises, or on premises under its control or possession, any alcoholic beverages; and generally 12 13 relating to alcoholic beverages in Calvert County.

25	[(c)] (E) (D) A person that violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on
26	conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 2 years
27	or both.
28	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
29	measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has
30	been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to
31	each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is
32	enacted shall take effect July 1, 2015.
