## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages – Barbershop and Beauty Salon License**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a barbershop and beauty salon beer and wine license in  
4 Harford County; authorizing the Harford County Liquor Control Board to issue a  
5 license to a holder of certain business permits; authorizing the holder of the license  
6 to serve certain amounts of beer and wine for on–premises consumption to an  
7 individual in a single day under certain circumstances; prohibiting the license from  
8 being transferred to another location; setting the hours of operation for the license;  
9 authorizing a license holder to purchase alcoholic beverages from a wholesaler or a  
10 retailer; requiring a license holder to comply with certain record–keeping provisions  
11 and certain alcohol awareness training requirements; establishing an annual license  
12 fee; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Harford County.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
2 That Section(s) 22–1001 of Article – Alcoholic Beverages of the Annotated Code of Maryland  
3 be renumbered to be Section(s) 22–1001.1.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read  
5 as follows:

6 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

7 22–102.

8 This title applies only in Harford County.

9 **22–1001.**

10 (A) **THERE IS A BARBERSHOP AND BEAUTY SALON BEER AND WINE LICENSE.**

11 (B) **THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE TO A HOLDER OF:**

12 (1) **A BARBERSHOP PERMIT ISSUED UNDER § 4–501 OF THE BUSINESS**  
13 **OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE; OR**

14 (2) **A BEAUTY SALON PERMIT ISSUED UNDER § 5–501 OF THE**  
15 **BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE.**

16 (C) **THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO PROVIDE, BY SALE**  
17 **OR SERVED AT NO COST, TO A PARTICIPATING INDIVIDUAL NOT MORE THAN TWO**  
18 **12–OUNCE SERVINGS OF BEER OR TWO 5–OUNCE SERVINGS OF WINE BY THE GLASS**  
19 **FOR ON–PREMISES CONSUMPTION IN A SINGLE DAY WHILE THE INDIVIDUAL:**

20 (1) **IS PROVIDED A SERVICE UNDER § 4–501 OR § 5–501 OF THE**  
21 **BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE; OR**

22 (2) **IS ATTENDING A FUND–RAISING EVENT AT THE BARBERSHOP OR**  
23 **BEAUTY SALON FOR WHICH THE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF INSPECTIONS,**  
24 **LICENSES, AND PERMITS HAS ISSUED A PERMIT.**

25 (D) **THE LICENSE MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO ANOTHER LOCATION.**

26 (E) **THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY PROVIDE BEER AND WINE DURING NORMAL**  
27 **BUSINESS HOURS BUT NOT LATER THAN 9 P.M.**

28 (F) **THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY PURCHASE BEER AND WINE FROM A**

1 **WHOLESALE OR FROM A RETAILER.**

2 **(G) AN ESTABLISHMENT FOR WHICH THE LICENSE IS ISSUED IS SUBJECT TO:**

3 **(1) THE RECORD-KEEPING PROVISIONS UNDER § 22-1904 OF THIS**  
4 **TITLE; AND**

5 **(2) THE ALCOHOL AWARENESS TRAINING REQUIREMENTS UNDER §**  
6 **4-505 OF THIS ARTICLE.**

7 **(H) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$400.**

8 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July**  
9 **1, 2020.**
