2 3 4	(ii) The license may be issued to any local unit of a nationwide bona fide nonprofit organization or club composed solely of members who served in the armed forces of the United States in any war in which the United States has engaged which:
5 6	1. Has held a charter from a national veterans' organization for a period of not less than 5 years prior to the time of making application for the license;
7 8	2. Has a bona fide membership of not less than 15 persons and dues of not less than \$5 per year per person;
9 10	3. Operates solely for the use of its own members and their guests when accompanied by members; and
11	4. Meets in a clubhouse principally used for no other purpose.
12 13	(III) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE FOR A SEVEN-DAY VETERANS LICENSE IS \$500.
