- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 24 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS

- 1 INDICATED.
- 2 (2) "DIFFERENTIAL IMPACT" MEANS A DIFFERENCE IN THE EFFECT
- 3 OF A BILL ON VARIOUS MEMBERS OF THE EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATION.
- 4 (3) "EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATION" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 5 3–101 OF THE STATE PERSONNEL AND PENSIONS ARTICLE.
- 6 (B) IF AN EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATION PUBLICLY SUPPORTS A BILL THAT IS
 7 INTRODUCED BY A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE EMPLOYEE
 8 ORGANIZATION SHALL SUBMIT TO THE PRIMARY SPONSOR OF THE BILL AND THE
- 9 STANDING COMMITTEE OR COMMITTEES TO WHICH THE BILL IS REFERRED BEFORE
- 10 THE BILL HEARING A WRITTEN STATEMENT, ON A FORM APPROVED BY THE
- 11 DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES, CERTIFYING THAT THE BILL WILL HAVE:
- 12 (1) MINIMAL OR NO DIFFERENTIAL IMPACT ON VARIOUS SUBGROUPS
 13 OF MEMBERS OF THE EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATION; OR
- 14 (2) MEANINGFUL DIFFERENTIAL IMPACT ON VARIOUS SUBGROUPS OF 15 MEMBERS OF THE EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATION.

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- 18 (d) "Employee organization" means a labor or other organization in which State 19 employees participate and that has as one of its primary purposes representing employees.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2019.
