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Motor Vehicle Administration – Selective Service Registration – Driver's License and Identification Card Applicants

4 FOR the purpose of making certain provisions of law relating to the Motor Vehicle 5 Administration's collection and electronic forwarding of Selective Service 6 registration information gender-neutral and expanding their applicability to 7 certain minors; altering the conditions under which certain information about 8 an applicant is forwarded to the Selective Service System; altering the contents 9 of the statement the Administration is required to include on an application for 10 a driver's license or an identification card; requiring the Administration to forward certain information about certain applicants with a notation that a 11 12 certain registration was refused; repealing a certain provision making the 13 Administration's collection and electronic forwarding of Selective Service registration information on certain individuals to the Selective Service System 14 contingent on the Administration's receipt of federal funds to pay for certain 15 16 start-up costs; repealing a certain provision requiring the Motor Vehicle 17 Administrator to initiate and monitor efforts to obtain certain federal funds and to report to the Department of Legislative Services when a certain contingency 18 19 is fulfilled; making certain technical corrections; and generally relating to the Motor Vehicle Administration and Selective Service registration. 20

IF REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW, CONSENTS TO Selective Service 23 registration and the forwarding of information to the Selective 24[Administration] **SYSTEM** under this section. 25 (2) In addition to the information required under this subtitle or Title 16 of this article, an application form for a driver's license or identification card or 26 27renewal of a driver's license or identification card shall contain a statement that the 28 [male] applicant:

18 19 20 21	(2) IF AN APPLICANT REFUSES SELECTIVE SERVICE REGISTRATION, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL FORWARD THE PERSONAL INFORMATION LISTED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM WITH A NOTATION THAT REGISTRATION WAS REFUSED.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act is contingent on the receipt by the Motor Vehicle Administration of sufficient federal funds to pay the Administration's initial start—up costs for computer programming changes necessary to implement the requirements of Section 1 of this Act related to the reporting of information to the Selective Service Administration.]

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Motor Vehicle Administrator shall initiate and monitor efforts to obtain federal funds for the purposes stated in Section 2 of this Act and shall report promptly to the Department of Legislative Services when federal funds have been received by the Administration and the contingency specified in Section 2 of this Act has been fulfilled.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.

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
