### A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

# Higher Education – The Senator Delores G. Kelley Scholarship Program – Establishment

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Senator Delores G. Kelley Scholarship Program for  $\mathbf{5}$ students who are eligible to receive the maximum federal Pell Grant and are 6 residents of certain counties or graduates of high schools in certain counties to 7 receive a scholarship to be used for certain purposes at historically Black colleges 8 and universities in the State; authorizing counties to participate in the Program; 9 requiring certain counties to pay certain amounts for scholarships awarded under 10 the Program; and generally relating to the Senator Delores G. Kelley Scholarship 11 Program.

8 (2) ANY STUDENT FINANCIAL AID, OTHER THAN A STUDENT LOAN, 9 RECEIVED BY A STUDENT WHO RECEIVES A SCHOLARSHIP UNDER THE PROGRAM 10 SHALL BE APPLIED FIRST TO PAY THE STUDENT'S TUITION AND FEES.

11 (C) FUNDS PROVIDED FOR THE PROGRAM SHALL SUPPLEMENT AND MAY 12 NOT SUPPLANT FEDERAL PELL GRANTS AND MAY BE USED ONLY FOR TUITION, 13 MANDATORY FEES, ROOM AND BOARD, AND BOOKS.

14 (D) EACH HBCU SHALL ADOPT POLICIES TO ESTABLISH:

15 (1) ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR A STUDENT RECEIVING A 16 SCHOLARSHIP UNDER THE PROGRAM;

17 **(2)** AWARD AMOUNTS;

18 (3) A PROCEDURE FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD
 19 PROVIDED TO AN ELIGIBLE STUDENT; AND

20(4)ANY OTHER POLICIES NECESSARY FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF21THE PROGRAM.

23 EACH HBCU SHALL DESIGNATE TWO FULL-TIME STAFF MEMBERS TO 24 RECRUIT, MENTOR, AND ADVISE ELIGIBLE STUDENTS.

25 **18–3906.** 

26 (A) EACH COUNTY MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM.

27 (B) EACH COUNTY PARTICIPATING IN THE PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE AN 28 EQUAL MATCH TO THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT AWARDED UNDER THE

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### **1 PROGRAM FOR EACH SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT FROM THAT COUNTY.**

2 (C) IF A COUNTY DOES NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM, THE STUDENTS 3 WHO RESIDE IN THAT COUNTY AND GRADUATED FROM A HIGH SCHOOL IN THAT 4 COUNTY ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A SCHOLARSHIP UNDER THE PROGRAM.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 6 1, 2023.
