2 (B) THE PROHIBITION IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION DOES NOT 3 APPLY IF:

4 (1) THE WOMAN'S PREGNANCY IS THE RESULT OF AN ACT OF RAPE OR 5 INCEST; OR

6 (2) THE WOMAN HAS A LIFE-ENDANGERING PHYSICAL CONDITION
7 CAUSED BY OR ARISING FROM THE PREGNANCY ITSELF THAT WOULD, AS CERTIFIED
8 BY A PHYSICIAN, PLACE THE WOMAN IN DANGER OF DEATH UNLESS AN ABORTION IS
9 PERFORMED.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2021.

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
