Institutions of Postsecondary Education – Electronic Account, Service, and Communications Device Privacy Protection

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting an institution of postsecondary education from 5 requiring a student or an applicant for admission to provide access to a 6 student's or applicant's personal account or service through an electronic 7 communications device, to disclose any user name, account name, password, or 8 other means for accessing certain accounts or services through an electronic 9 communications device, or to install on certain electronic communications 10 devices software that monitors or tracks electronic content; prohibiting an 11 institution of postsecondary education from taking, or threatening to take, 12 certain disciplinary actions for a student's or applicant's refusal to provide 13 certain access. disclose certain information, or install certain software; 14 providing that this Act may not be construed to prohibit a student or an applicant from voluntarily disclosing any user name, password, or other means 15 for accessing certain accounts or services through an electronic communications 16 device; defining certain terms; and generally relating to electronic account, 17 18 service, and communications devices used by applicants to and students of institutions of postsecondary education. 19
